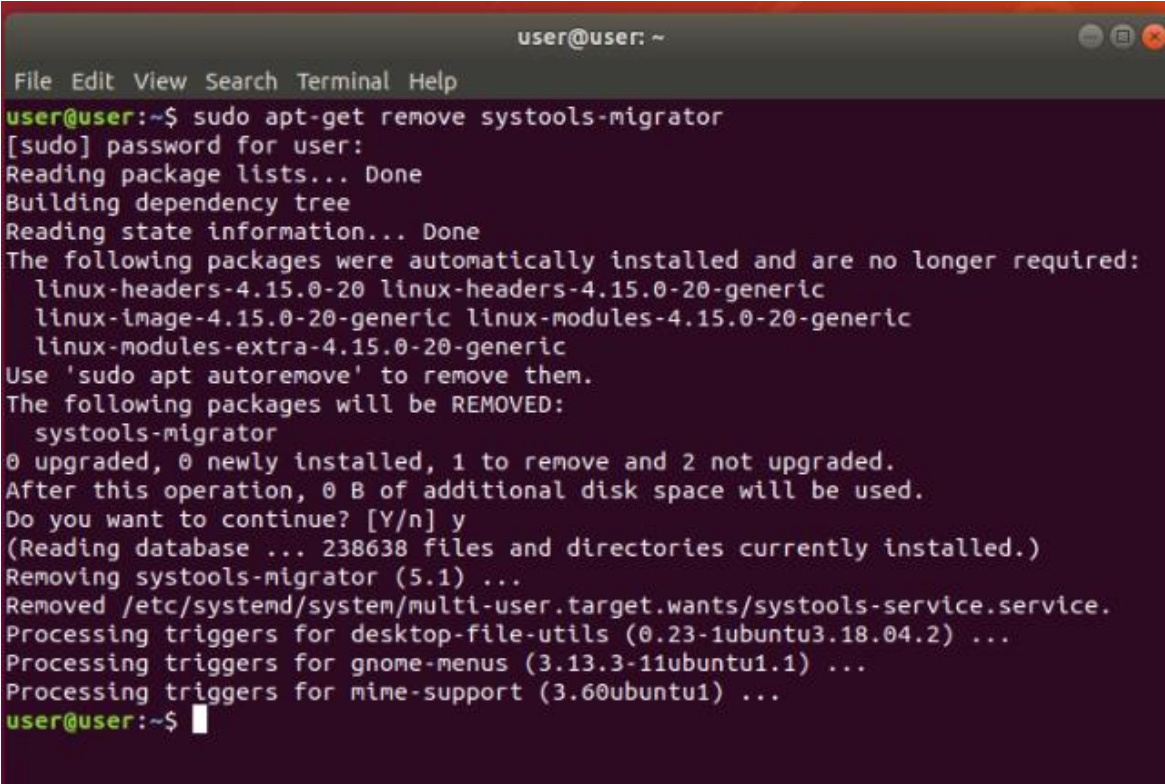


Uninstallation of SysTools Migrator

You can uninstall **SysTools Migrator** properly on your linux system by performing the following steps:

- First right-click on the desktop and open Terminal Window
- In the terminal window write the command: ***sudo apt-get remove systools-migrator***
- Once pressed enter, you need to provide the Password of current Admin/User.
- Now, the uninstallation of SysTools Migrator will begin and you will be asked to continue the uninstallation. Enter 'y' to continue.
